This two-day training program will be presented by CLINIC Attorneys Peggy Gleason and Mary Holper. The impact of crimes training will review crime-based inadmissibility and deportability issues, waivers and remedies, and practice pointers for representing an immigrant with a conviction or a pending criminal charge. Proving good moral character for naturalization and other applications will be discussed. The overview of removal will cover how people get placed in immigration court proceedings, the rights of individuals stopped and/or arrested by ICE, and what happens after court proceedings commence. We will describe relief from removal. Motions to reopen, motions to change venue, motions to terminate, and motions to administratively close will be described. Both trainings are interactive, with large and small group exercises. An overview of pending legislation will also be covered on Day One.

This training is for staff of Catholic Charities programs and other community-based organizations (CBOs) with IRS (501(c)(3)) nonprofit status, and attorneys and legal worker staff of private law offices. Directions: From the West: Take I-40 east to Raleigh, pass the airport, take the Wade Avenue exit. Stay on Wade Avenue until it merges into Capital Blvd. Capital becomes Dawson Street. Once you cross Hargett Street our building is at the next intersection on the corner of Martin and Dawson. We are on the right side of the street next to a fire station and across the street from a park.

From the South: Take I-40 to the Beltline (I-440). Get off at S. Saunders Street, northbound. Take this it will become McDowell. Take McDowell to Martin Street. Turn left on Martin. Go one block to Dawson. Our building is on the corner.

From the East: Take Hwy 64 toward Raleigh. It will become New Bern Avenue in Raleigh. Do not get on the Beltline (I-440). Stay on New Bern , which will become

Edenton downtown Raleigh. Turn left on Dawson, cross Hillsborough Street, Morgan Street and Hargett Street. We are on the corner of Dawson and Martin. Our building does not have parking but there are a number of parking structures in the area.
